DOODLE DESIGN CONTEST MECHANICS JUNIOR YOUTH, SENIOR YOUTH

In-charge: Ptr. Jim Colico

1. Open to all doodling enthusiasts, ages 12 and above, and registered delegates of Camp 2018.
2. The contest is teamwork, and each group must have three (3) contestants who are in the same area.
3. There is no limit of number of groups per local church and area.
4. Groups must be registered on or before the contest proper (to be announced later) at the registration area. For each group, these must be submitted:
 - a. Contestants' receipt of Camp 2016 registration
 - b. Completed contest registration form (forms are available at the registration area)
5. Registered groups must proceed to the selected contest venue on or before the contest proper. Late and incomplete groups will automatically be disqualified.
6. Contestants must provide their own pen.
7. The contestants will have two (2) hours to doodle.
8. The criteria for judging are as follows:
 - Artistic merit (30%) Clarity and quality of work
 - Creativity and Originality (30%) Style, technique and skill
 - Theme communication (30%) Relevance of the image to the theme of the contest
 - Teamwork (10%) Participation and harmony of all members of the group
9. There will be first, second and third places in each category.
10. All contest mechanics can be downloaded at the church website pmcc4w.org.
11. Deadline for Submission of Entries (Youth and Adult) on or before March 27, 2018 (Ministers Meeting). Entry Fee per Local Church is P500. Entry Fee after March 27 is P1,000
12. Schedule and venue of the contest will be posted at the lobby on the 1st day of the Camp.
13. Those who won the 1st place will no longer join the same contest.
14. Winners will be posted at the lobby on Friday morning of the camp.
15. Awardees must be in proper attire. No pants, no short skirts or dress are allowed.
